"30 years of Binacom: past, present and future of trans-border communication"

April 17-18, 2020

Encuentro Binacom is a biennial space built by the main educational institutions with communication and journalism programs in the Mexico-United States cross-border area. It offers the opportunity to share experiences, reflections and points of view among professors, students, researchers and professionals in the various areas of communication (journalism, web design, graphic communication, photography, sound production, audiovisual and multimedia production) to strengthen relationships that respond to the needs of this region.

The Encuentro 2020 will take place at the University of Arizona-Tucson, April 17-18, 2020. The Conference includes two keynote speakers, Rosental Alves (Knight Center for Journalism in the Americas) and Ana Cristina Ruelas (Article 19, Mexico). Registrants will participate in workshops, discussion panels, research sessions, exhibitions and presentation of communication and journalism projects, as well as networking activities.

FORMS OF PARTICIPATION

There are several ways in which professors, students, researchers and professionals can participate. Details about how and where to submit a project or panel proposal will be posted soon.

PANELS

Two to four panelists discuss a theme related to the borderlands. A moderator will be part of the panel.

Sending proposals:

Those interested in participating in panels should send in two documents:

- (1) Title and abstract 250-300 without author/s' names
- (2) A title page with the following information: title, name, affiliated institution, address, telephone number, and e-mail addresses of all authors/participants on the panel.

EXHIBITION OF PROJECTS

Participants can also present research projects, journalism reports/projects, web design, graphic design, photography, sound production/audio storytelling, audiovisual production and multimedia.

Photography: prepare your digital project with title (.jpg or .png, 150-300 dpi, maximum 1 Mb). When you receive the notification that your work was accepted you will have to be delivered, assembled and ready to be exposed (format no less than 4x6 nor more than 16x20), to one of your professors who is part of Binacom. Include a title page with: title, name of author/s, synopsis and credits (if applicable).

Video: send digital projects of fiction or documentary (.mp4, .mov or H.264) no more than 10 minutes long accompanied. Include a title page with: title, name of author/s, synopsis and credits (if applicable).

Radio and audio: digital audio or radio project (.mp3, .aif or .wav) with a duration of no more than 7 minutes and attach its technical sheet. The data sheet for video and audio includes: title, duration, name of the authors, synopsis and credits.

Online projects: send in the URL of your project and title page that includes: title, name of author/s, synopsis and credits.

Journalism: send your projects or works (.pdf or .jpg) along with a title page that includes: title, name of author/s, synopsis and credits (if applicable).

Graphic design: digital work (.pdf or .jpg). The exhibition of these projects during the meeting will be exclusively digital. Include a title page with: title, name of author/s, synopsis and credits (if applicable).

WORKSHOPS/TRAINING SESSIONS

Workshops and training sessions will be offered during the encuentro/meeting. Sessions will be between 1-3 hours in length and can be in one or two sessions.

Workshops/training sessions will focus on building skills and knowledge in areas related to communication/journalism research and/or production. Students and professionals can sign up for the workshops/training sessions that fit their interests. Programming information about workshops/training sessions will be published online soon.

Sending in proposals for workshops/training sessions:

Those interested in offering a workshop/training session should send in the following documents.

- (1) Title and abstract of 250-300 words describing the workshop/training session
- (2) Name of the person leading the workshop/training session as well as: title of the workshop/training session, affiliated institution, address, telephone number, and e-mail address.

Deadline to send proposals:

Before midnight Tuesday, March 13, 2020.
